Cooperative Work Experience (Co-Op) :



This is a type of work experience where you

get paid for your efforts and have the opportunity to learn about transitions that take place from high school to college, and from training to work.

Internship:



You have the opportunity to gain an in-depth view of a desired career by taking part in an unpaid work experience for a minimum of 50 hours. You are scheduled during your BOCES class period and must provide your own transportation. The internship has the possibility to turn into a paid experience, which is called a Capstone.

Community Service:

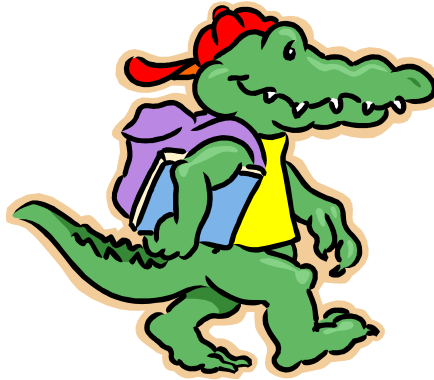


You are able to participate in at least 60 hours of community service and must keep a documentation log with signatures and hours. Upon completion you will be required to do a class presentation about your

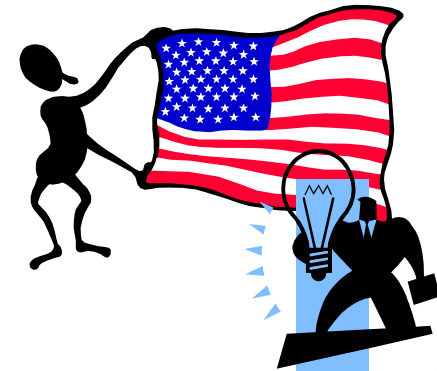

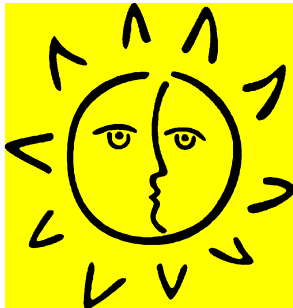

- You will be earning high school credit while taking part in this program, providing all the requirements and performance criteria are met.
- You will learn if you really want to pursue a certain career tract.
- You will be observed and evaluated by your CTE instructor, as well as your on-site supervisor.
